This presentation shows how to setup a Variable List.

Variable Lists are used to group Sales Items together and link them to buttons on Preferential Screens.

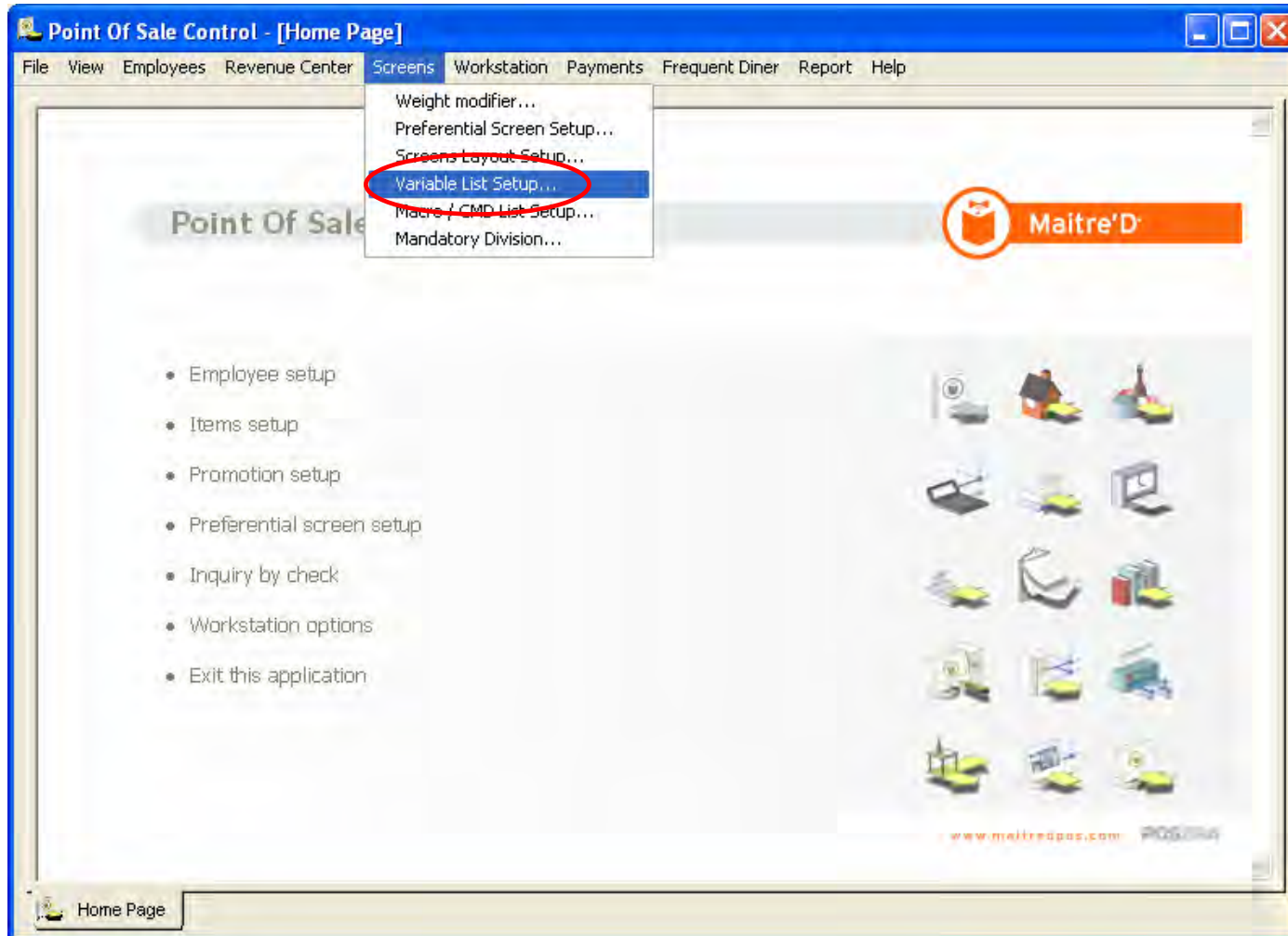
They can also be used in Weighted Modifiers and Macro Commands.

Click to continue

In the P.O.S. Control module, click on Screens, then on Variable List Setup.

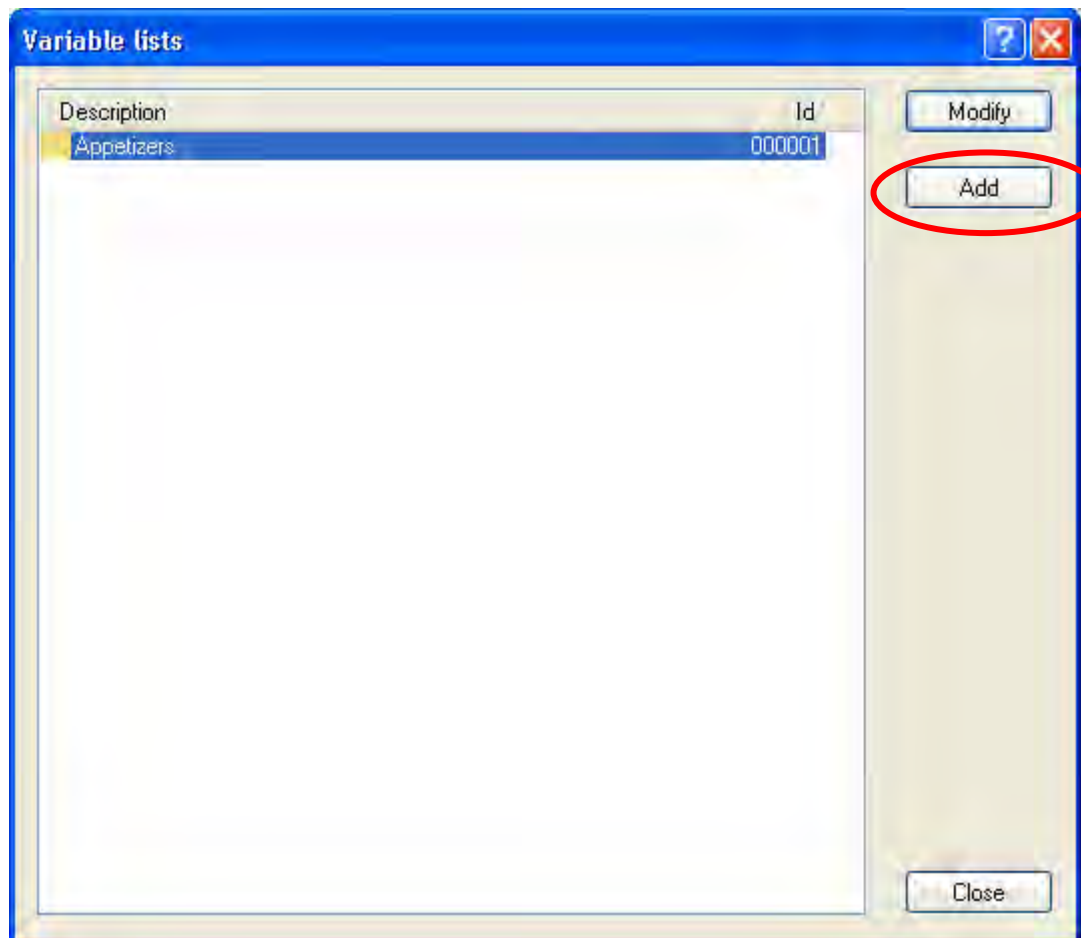




## Variable Lists

Click on ADD.





## Variable Lists

Click to continue

Enter a **Description** for the Variable List.

Enable the use **Fix Layout** option to set the layout of the screen.

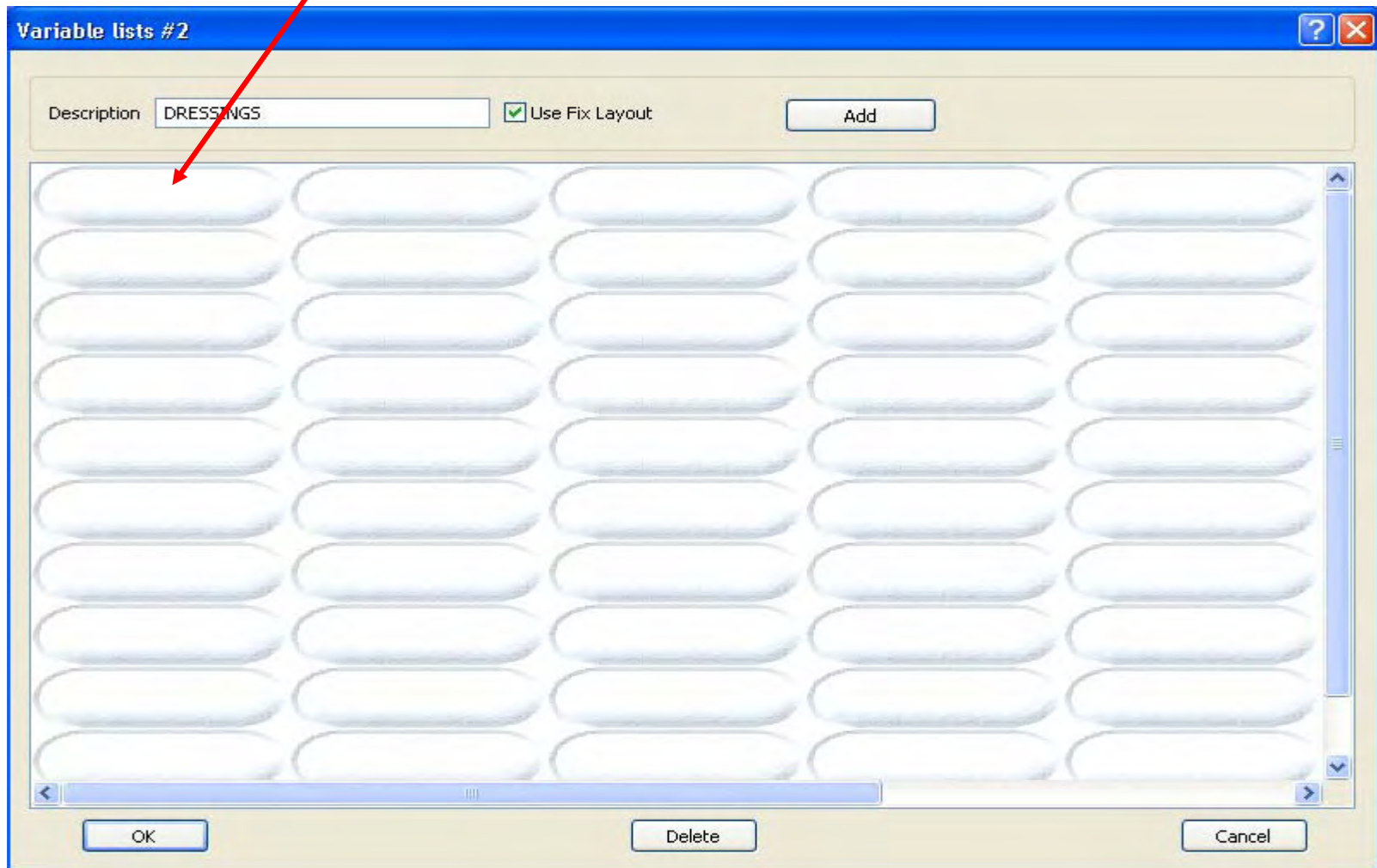

Click on an empty placeholder button.

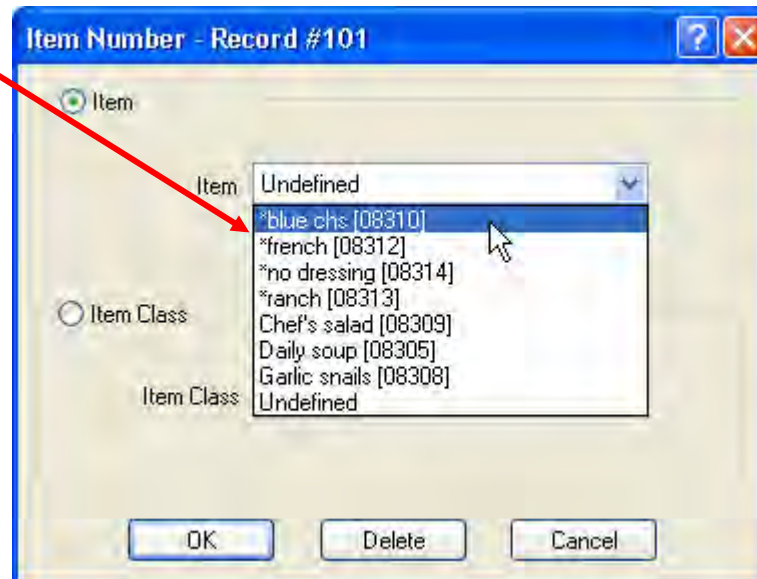

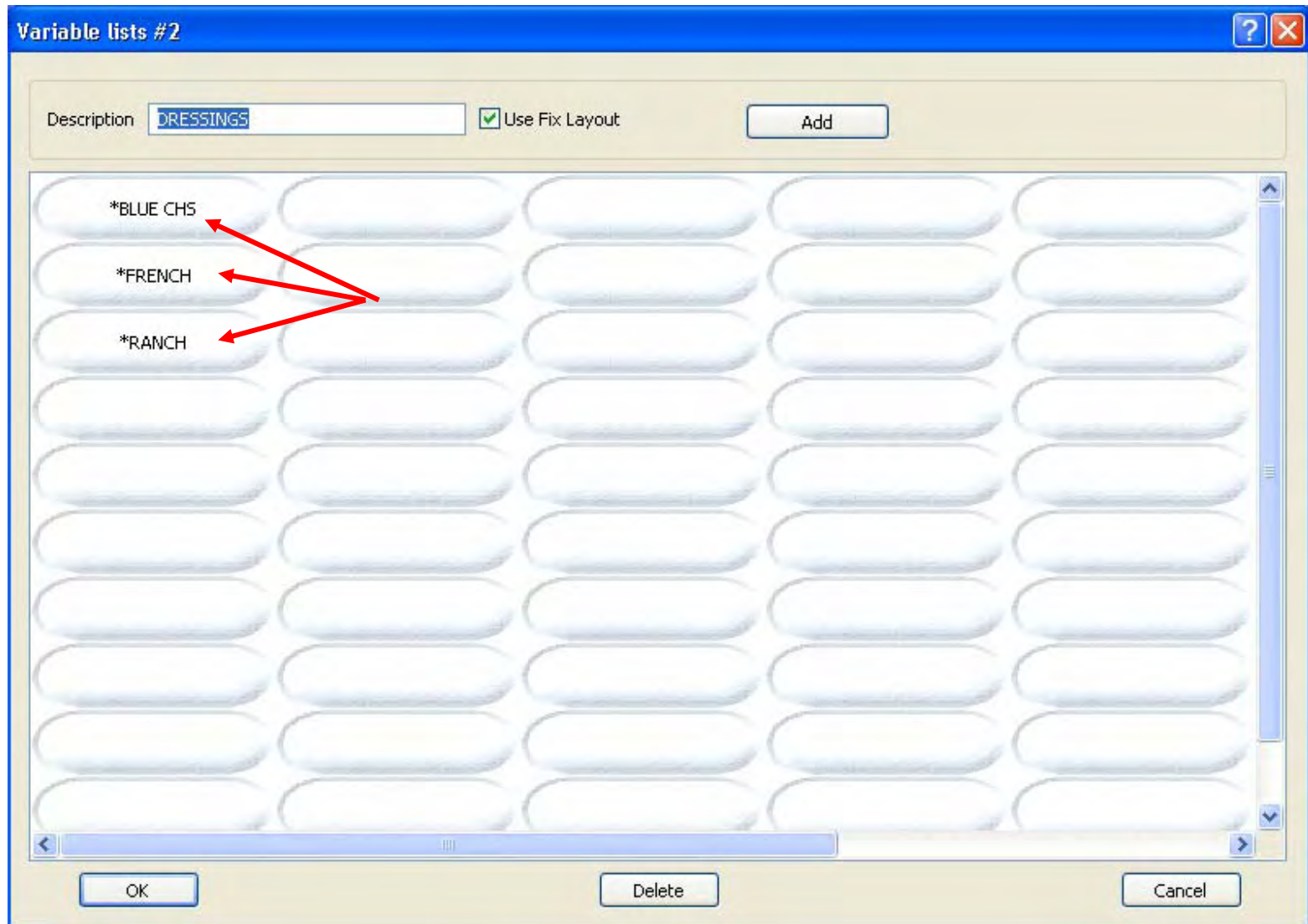
Click to continue

Click to continue

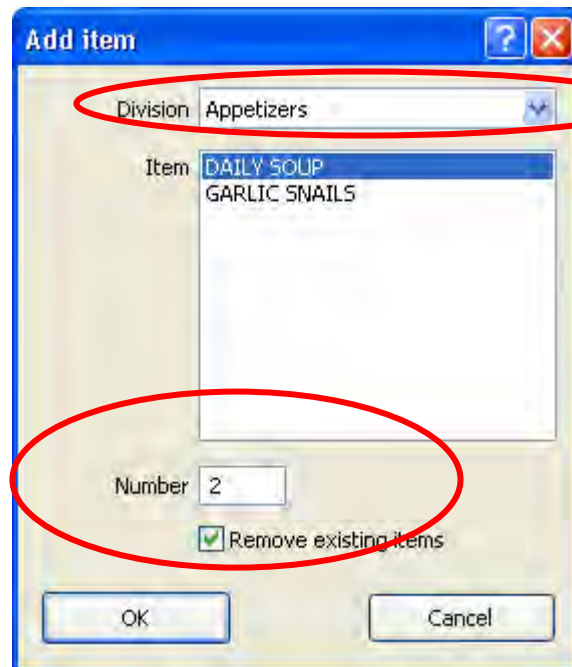
Select the **Division** to choose from.

Highlight the first Item to include.

Enter the number of Items to include.

Enable the **Remove Existing Items** to overwrite the existing Variable List, or disable the same option to add Items and the end of the Variable List.

Always remove existing items  
Click on OK.

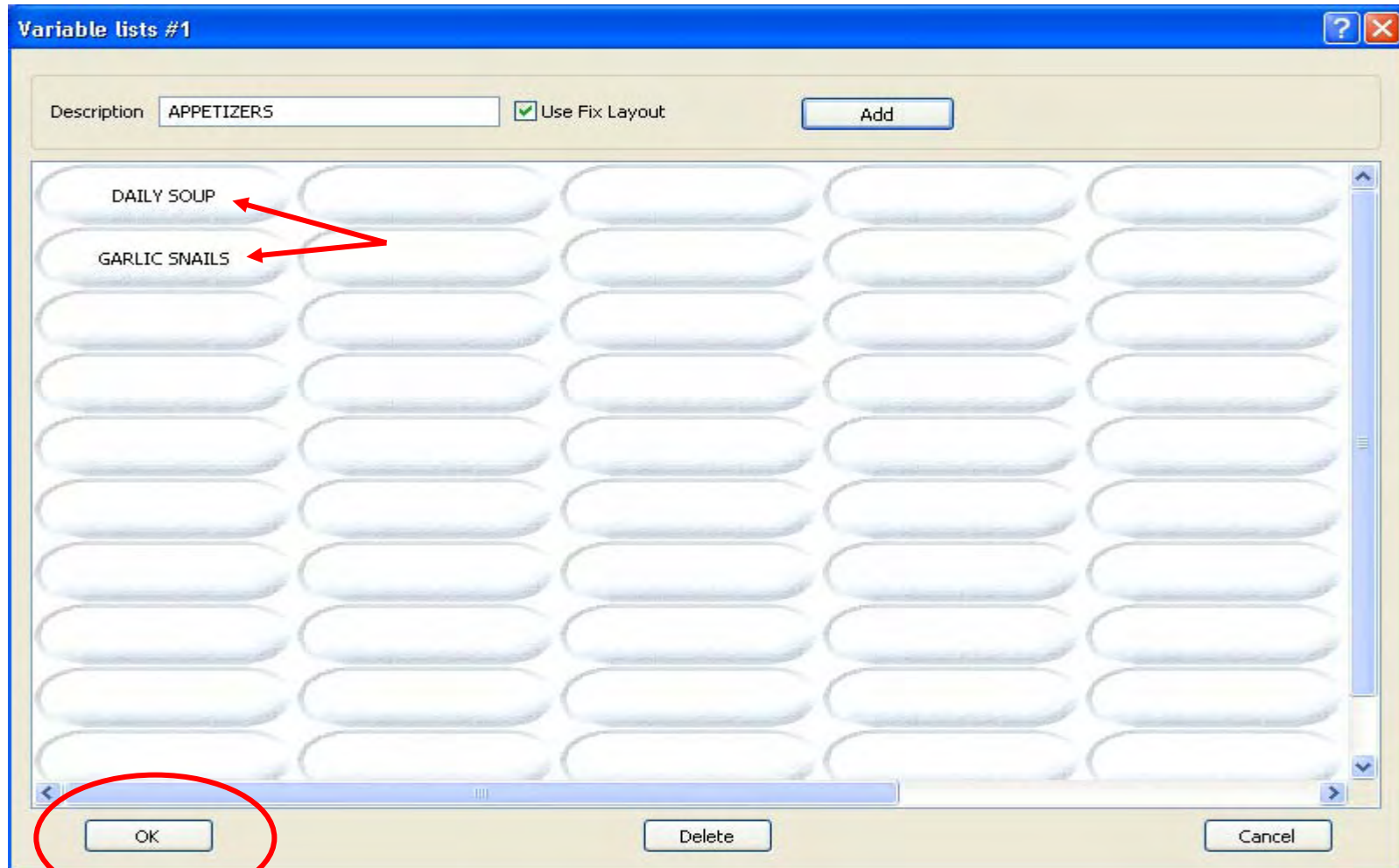

Click on OK again.

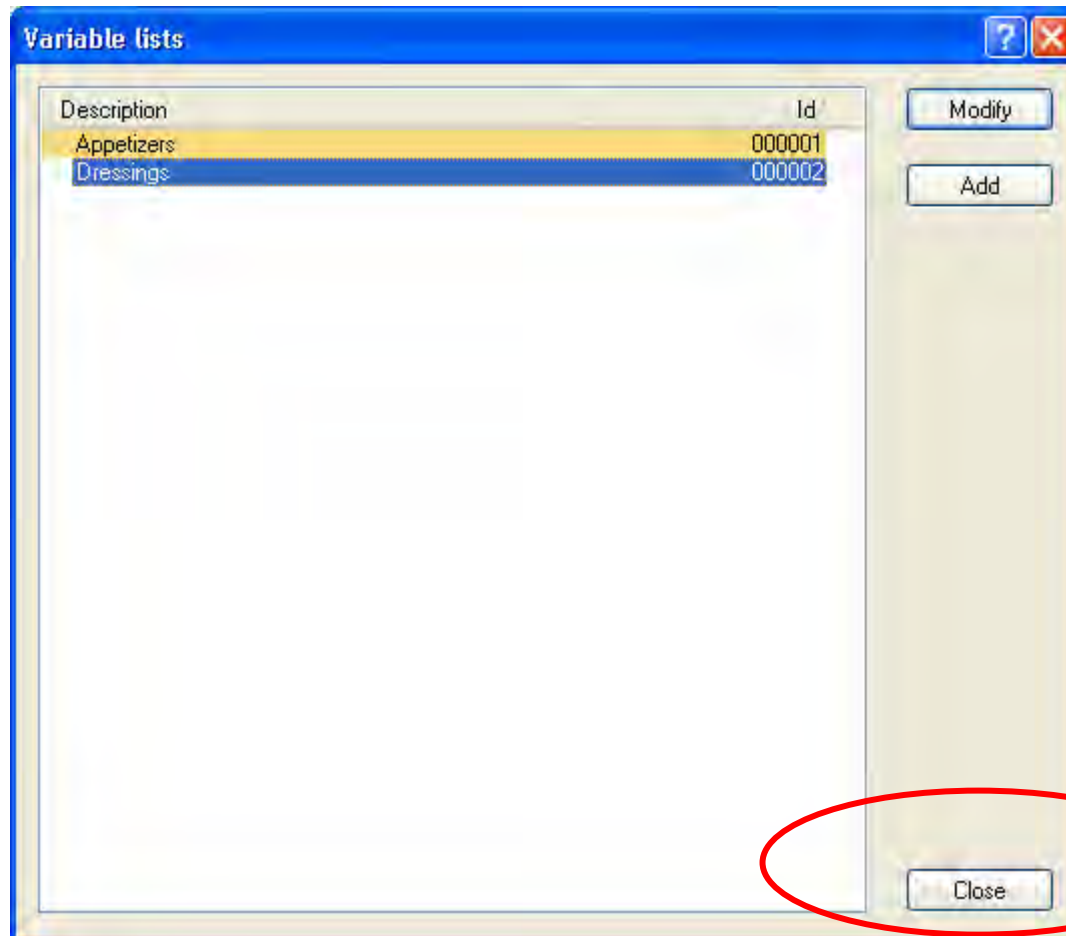




## Variable Lists
